On October 18, 2008, the American Indian Heritage Celebration Planning Committee, an inter-tribal collaboration of American Indian leaders of the Santa Clara Valley, will bring together thousands of people to the **National Hispanic University** (14271 Story Road, San Jose, CA 95127) from **10 am to 6 pm** for a **daylong event celebrating American Indian heritage, history, language, art, music and community.**

Our full day celebration will include a health fair, cultural sharing, language presentations, arts and crafts booths, music, dance performances, and cultural activities. Our program targets all age groups and the program objectives include:

- Promoting wellness and health education to the community, focusing on issues specifically targeting American Indians (i.e. diabetes, heart disease, substance abuse, and mental health) by adjoining traditional American Indian diet and healing practices with modern medical, health and wellness resources.
- Promoting a sense of unity among American Indian peoples and the community through cultural sharing and educational presentations on American Indian history, language and heritage.
- Celebrating “life” and promoting strength, survival and prosperity for American Indians as well as the entire community.

The Planning Committee seeks financial donations as well as donations of food, drinks and related hospitality supplies. We also seek partnerships with hospitals, health care agencies, food distributors, community organizations, and major sponsors interested in participating in Santa Clara Valley’s ***Third Annual*** American Indian Heritage Celebration. Your donation is tax deductible, as the Indian Health Center of Santa Clara Valley, the Planning Committee’s fiscal agent, is a 501(c)3 Nonprofit Corporation.

Other Planning Committee members include the American Indian Alliance; American Indian Education; Evergreen Valley College; the Indian Health Center; Many Nations, One People; Washoe Native TANF; Native Voice TV; San Jose City College; and American Indian community members from Santa Clara County, Monterey County, San Luis Obispo County, and from other parts of the United States.
